Reaching your future goals starts with a high school program plan. The sample plan below provides you with a sense of the basic requirements for an Alberta high school diploma. You can also talk to your school's counsellor about myblueprint.ca, which allows you to design a plan based on courses offered at the school of your choice and links to a Canada-wide database of post-secondary and employment opportunities based on that plan.
