


# How your Christian program fees are used


**Buildings/Grounds**  
The Society owns, operates, and maintains the three ECS buildings and properties.




**Development**  
Teachers participate in regular Christian professional development.




**Supports**  
Students are supported by a Christian Therapist and a Pastoral Care Leader in each school.



**Bible Curriculum**  
Students learn a locally developed Bible curriculum.

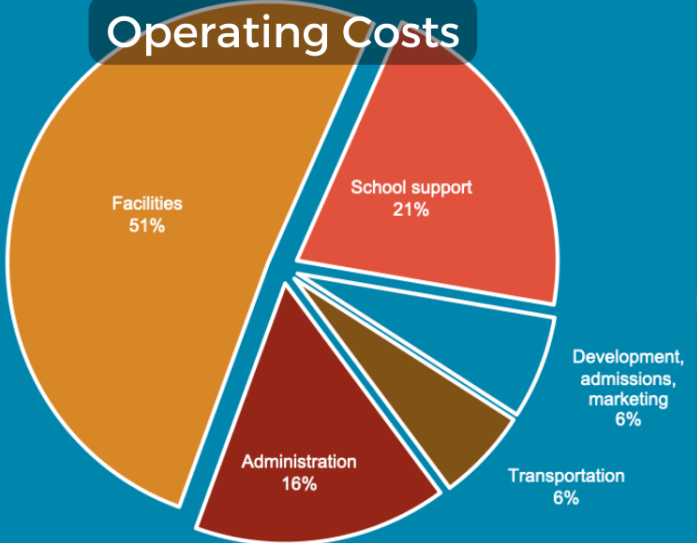


**Teaching for Transformation (TfT)**  
TfT integrates the Alberta curriculum in the Christian worldview and consists of three core components; Storyline, Throughlines, and FLEx. The TfT Framework shapes students' identity both as a learner and as a disciple of Jesus.



The annual Christian Program Fee, collected by **the Society Office (ESCE), a nonprofit organization**, provides students with Christian programming and school facilities; ESCE owns/operates all school buildings and manages the Christian Program independently of EPSB.
